Information for entrants:

1) Not all entries will be displayed. All works submitted, must be original works made by the photographer. Manipulated images may be submitted but such images must be primarily photographic in nature and every element in the image must have been created by the submitting photographer. This is a juried photography exhibit and our panel of three judges will select the photos to be included in the show as well as the award winners. Their decisions will be final.

2) In addition to the awards selected by the judges, the visitors at the opening night reception on Saturday, March 16th, on the second floor of the Fremont Main Library, will vote to select the winner of the "People's Choice Award."

3) A list of the photographs selected for inclusion in the exhibit will be posted on the FCAC website and emailed to entrants by Thursday March 14th.

4) If you have photos that were not selected for inclusion in the show, you can pick them up at the FCAC office at 3375 Country Drive, Fremont on weekdays between 11am and 2pm. The FCAC will not be responsible for unclaimed prints and may dispose of any remaining items after May 31, 2019.

5) Please indicate after each print on the registration form whether you are interested in selling your print. Either indicate NFS (Not For Sale) or, if it is available for purchase, indicate your price. This should be the price for the framed print. The title cards for accepted prints this year will indicate whether your item is available for sale.

A master list will be kept at the reference desk of the library of items available for purchase and the prices. If visitors to the show are interested in purchasing your print, they will be given your contact information. If you do not want your contact information given out, please mark your entries NFS.

Please note that any sales are between you and the buyer. The FCAC and Library are not parties to any sales. Any prints sold must remain in the exhibit until the final day (April 13, 2019).
